In 2025 the National meeting will be held at Steam Hotel in Västerås, in the Stockholm-region, 1 hour train from Stockholm.

The meeting follows two successful meetings, pre- and post- pandemic respectively in Lund 2018 and Linköping in 2022. Linköping attracted around 450 participants despite still being in the shadow of the pandemic.
